Hello everyone (or almost everyone, I fear I may have missed some folks on this initial distribution but Janice will follow up to ensure everyone is looped in)

Yesterday, I got the attached letter from FCM approving \$125k for the EV charging network project to get everything ready for capital funding for a network from Kamloops to Haida Gwaii and points in between and beyond.

Thank you for your support in getting this initiative to this point where we can start to launch it.

Next Steps:

1. We'll be signing the contract with FCM over the next couple of weeks
2. Janice and/or I will be in touch with each RD to assemble an Advisory Committee
3. CEA will invoice the 5 RD's for the \$9,000 each committed contingent on a successful FCM grant application
4. We'll refine a workplan (in collaboration with municipalities and RD's) and review the draft plan at an Advisory Committee kickoff
5. Janice and I will be in PG in the first week of June for a conference so we'll probably try to get in a little road-trip at that time as well.

Thank you for your enthusiasm and ongoing support. I am really looking forward to working with everyone in RDNC, RDKS, RDNB, RDFFC, and CRD over the coming year.


Re: Support for the Electric Vehicle Charging Network Collaboration Project
