1. Brief Description of Proposed Use of Grant Being Applied For:

~~As a part of a much larger, overall community emergency plan, we will be creating an inventory of emergency supplies for use in any emergency. We will secure training for volunteers in a number of areas including First Aid.~~
To this end, we wish to have a full First Aid kit available for those volunteer first responders in a central place. We will purchase a WorkSafe BC level 3 first aid kit as well as a back board and accessories. These supplies will be stored in a secure place and added to (an AED and oxygen concentrator for example) as other funds become available. Given our distance from Quesnel, and the fact that the clinic on the Nazko reserve is only staffed for 4 days per week, it is essential that the whole community has access to help during medical emergencies and situations such as the wildfires of 2017. As previously stated, this is part of a much larger, community plan.

2. Start date of the project: May 15, 2018

End date for the project: October 15, 2018 or as soon as the supplies can be purchased and a storage space created.

3. How will you indicate that the CRD is contributing to your organization?:

When a secure area is created for the First Aid supplies, a sign will be put up to acknowledge that the First Aid supplies were obtained through a grant from the CRD. There will also be an acknowledgement printed in the Nazko News, our monthly community newsletter.
