Timing: Ideally prior to winter months - completion by end of October

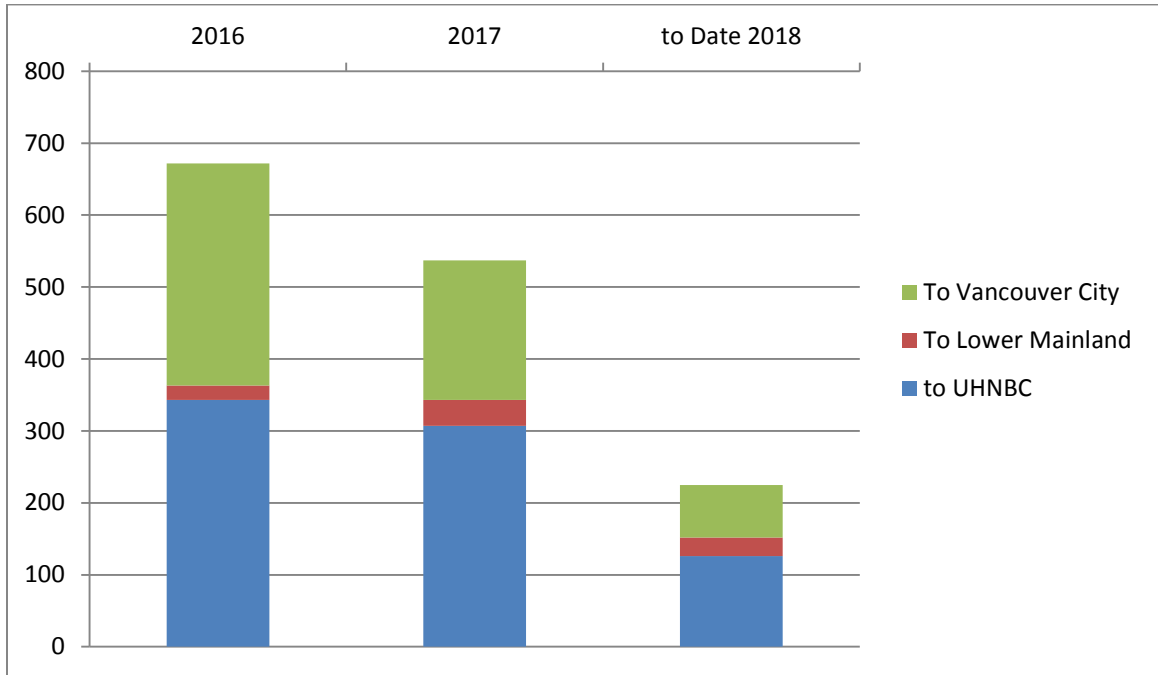
Project Scope: The University Hospital of Northern BC serves as a regional hospital for the area represented by Northern Health. Delivery to 300,000 patients in 600,000 sq. km. often means that travel needs to take place. Spirit of the North Healthcare Foundation provides equipment, education and enhancements to healthcare t this area within the scope of our generous Donors.

The Northern Health Connections bus is a great way for patients to travel at low – or no cost. Currently patients at G.R. Baker Memorial travel every Tuesday in to UHNBC and return. They also travel annually to the lower mainland for specialty appointments. These locations include Chilliwack, Abbotsford, and Vancouver. G.R. Baker has requested funding from Spirit of the North to provide a bus shelter at G.R. Baker Memorial for these patients who are currently waiting in unanticipated weather for periods of time.
