Please be advised that TELUS c/o Cypress Land Services Inc. has completed the public consultation process, following Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada, Default Public Consultation Process. TELUS is respectfully requesting, from the Cariboo Regional District (CRD) Board, that concurrence be issued for the TELUS tower proposal in an effort to provide TELUS wireless communications services in the Bouchie Lake area. Enclosed please find evidence of the following efforts regarding this public consultation process.

On June 29, 2018, an information package was submitted to the CRD formalizing the initiation of the consultation process (please see **Appendix 1: Information Package**).

On July 16, 2018, notification letters were sent to residents and other affected parties within a radius of three times the height of the proposed tower (90 metres). The notification letter was to advise residents of the proposed installation and to offer an opportunity to obtain additional information and provide comments (please see **Appendix 2: Affidavit of Notification**).

On July 20, 2018, a notice was placed in the Quesnel Cariboo Observer newspaper (please see **Appendix 3: Newspaper Tear Sheet**).

On August 20, 2018 the consultation period ended. During the consultation period, three (3) comments of support were received (please see **Appendix 4: Comments & Responses Tracker**).

TELUS is committed to working with the community and staff to supply TELUS wireless services to the Bouchie Lake area. TELUS looks forward to Council concurrence for the proposed wireless communications facility project, please find in **Appendix 5: Sample Resolution**, a sample resolution which may be used. Overview

Cypress Land Services Inc., in our capacity as agents to TELUS, is submitting this information package to formalize the consultation process related to the installation and operation of a telecommunications facility. We have been in preliminary consultation with Cariboo Regional District and in order to provide improved, dependable wireless services a new facility is required. This information package is intended to formalize the consultation process.

Proposed Site

The subject property is located at 2907 Pinnacles Road, Bouchie Lake, BC. This is an existing TELUS C.O. site. The proposed installation consists of a 30.0 metre triangular self-support tower structure with three (3) panel antennas and a lightning rod with tower mounted equipment cabinets at the base. The facility is proposed in the northeast corner of the property with an existing access off Pinnacles Road to ensure 24/7 access. Please see **Schedule A: Tower Site Location.**

Rationale for Site Selection

TELUS seeks to maintain and improve high quality, dependable network services. In order to improve network performance, TELUS is seeking to add the proposed communications installation to improve service in the Bouchie Lake area.

The proposed site is a result of many considerations. When a telecommunications carrier is determining a location for new wireless installation it must consider a number of factors to ensure the new installation operates effectively and results in reliable wireless services for the immediate community. Some of the considerations include frequency of operation, local topography, patterns of wireless users, building heights, road patterns, availability of land and existing structures. TELUS investigated the area for collocation options on nearby tower sites and unfortunately there are no nearby structures to utilize.

Proposal Details

A 30 metre galvanized triangular light duty self-support tower with tower mounted equipment at tower base is proposed. TELUS has completed preliminary design plans (**Schedule B: Preliminary Plans**). These preliminary design plans are subject to final engineered design, land survey and approval of Transport Canada. Transport Canada approval may require tower lighting and/or marking; comments are pending.

Consultation Process with the Cariboo Regional District

It is our understanding that Cariboo Regional District does not have an adopted Telecommunications policy. Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada, requires all proponents to consult with the local land use authority and public, notwithstanding that ISED has exclusive jurisdiction in the licensing of telecommunication sites, such as the proposed tower. Following ISED's requirements, TELUS would like to initiate Default Public Consultation Process (as described in the Industry Canada circular, CPC-2-0-03, issue 5, commonly referred to as the "CPC"). Information on the "CPC" consultation process may be found on-line at: http://www.ic.gc.ca/eic/site/smt-gst.nsf/eng/sf08777.html.

In order to obtain comments, concerns or questions in regard to the proposed tower site, the CPC requires TELUS to send out notification packages to all properties located within three times the height of the proposed tower (90 metres). A notice will also be placed in the local paper. This comment period is a minimum of 30 days. We expect the public consultation process to commence in July 2018.

At the conclusion of the consultation process, TELUS will prepare a summary of comments received from the community as well as the replies provided by TELUS. TELUS is requesting that, subsequent to the completed consultation process a letter or resolution of concurrence will be issued by the Regional District.



SCHEDULE A TOWER SITE LOCATION





What is TELUS Proposing?

TELUS seeks to continue to provide high quality wireless telecommunications services to communities throughout British Columbia. Increasingly, communities depend on wireless voice, data and internet communications for business, personal enjoyment and personal security reasons. In order to ensure wireless services to Bouchie Lake, BC, TELUS is proposing to add a telecommunications facility.

The new facility is proposed to be located at 2907 Pinnacles Road, Bouchie Lake, BC. TELUS is proposing to install a 30.0 metre galvanized triangular light duty self-support tower with panel antennas mounted at the top of the tower with tower mounted equipment at the tower base, within an existing fenced compound. The proposed location is considered to be appropriate because it is an existing TELUS facility.

Regulatory Authority

Telecommunication providers are required by Innovation, Science, and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada, to consult with the local municipality and the general public regarding new installations. ISED does have exclusive jurisdiction over the approval and placement of telecommunications installations.

The consultation process will provide an opportunity for residents, stakeholders and landowners to obtain detailed information regarding the proposal and to provide comments for consideration. Any inquiries that are received as a result of this notification will be logged and submitted to the Cariboo Regional District (CRD) and ISED as part of our application for concurrence.

Local Municipality

The CRD does not have a telecommunications consultation process to guide the consultation process. As such, ISED's CPC consultation process will be followed. This process requires all properties within three times the structure height be notified (in this instance those within 90.0 metres). This notification is to provide the opportunity to obtain information regarding the proposal, ask questions and provide comments. The closing period for comments to be received by TELUS is **August 20, 2018**.

Location

The new facility is proposed to be located at 2907 Pinnacles Road in Bouchie Lake, BC at the coordinates N 53.020668°, W 122.605720°.

Safety Code 6

ISED requires all wireless carriers to operate in accordance with Health Canada's safety standards. TELUS attests that the installation described in this notification package will be installed and operated on an ongoing basis so as to comply with Health Canada's Safety Code 6, as may be amended from time to time.

Site Access

Access will be obtained through the property. Construction is expected to take approximately about a month.



Environment

TELUS confirms that the installation is excluded from environmental assessment under the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act. Any municipal environmental regulations will be followed.

Transport Canada

The tower will be constructed to include any aeronautical markings or lighting required by Transport Canada. Comments are pending.

Structural Considerations

TELUS confirms that the antenna structure described in this notification package will apply good engineering practices including, structural adequacy during construction.





A response to mass shootings in schools across the US, Miss Katelyn's GradeThrees Prepare for the *Inevitable* is about a hyper-vigilant teacher trying to prepare her students for, well, the inevitable.

The first 20 people in the audience will be given name tags, and be referred to as a specific students in Miss Katelyn's class. But the entire audience is encouraged to participate as students, as their teacher advises them on the best ways to deal with a rampaging gunman.

Miss Katelyn's Grade Threes, written and performed by Elena Belyea and directed by Emma Tibaldo. has been performed in fringe festivals across the country.


Belyea was inspired to write the play after an experience she had walking through a mall on Boxing Day a few years ago. It occurred to her that that place, in that moment, would be a prime spot to target if someone wanted to commit a mass shooting. Then she wondered why she had thought something so morbid in the first place.

Much like what happened to Belyea, she says her show is about

a woman "who, despite being a grounded, rational person, is experiencing the anxiety that I think a lot of people are feeling in this present moment, just in terms of not feeling safe in their own communities and schools."

The show is part of the Presentation series at the Sunset Theatre. The Presentation series brings in shows that have already been performed elsewhere across Canada to good reviews.

Karen Jeffery, the executive artistic director at Sunset Theatre, says the

show is "funny at the same time as it's gut wrenching. It's like watching a car wreck in a way - it's like, 'Oh my God.' The audience gets drawn into it in a way that

they become the grade threes.

The school principal also makes an appearance in the show, checking in on the class to see what Miss Katelyn is teaching them. A Wells local, James Douglas, is filling this role.

The show runs on July 23 and 24, 2018 and starts at 8 p.m. both nights. Tickets are available at the door.



- WHEREAS TELUS proposes to erect a wireless communications facility at the location of 2907 Pinnacles Road, Bouchie Lake, BC.
- AND WHEREAS proponents of telecommunication towers are regulated by Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada on behalf of the Government of Canada and as part of their approval, ISED requires proponents to consult with land use authorities as provided for in CPC-2-0-03;
- AND WHEREAS TELUS has consulted with the CRD following the CPC-2-0-03 and the CRD planning staff have no objection to the proposed telecommunications tower;
- AND WHEREAS TELUS has consulted with the public by notifying properties within three times the tower height, placed a newspaper notice in the local paper and has provided a 30-day period for written public comment;

AND WHEREAS there are no significant land use issues identified by the consultation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Clerk be instructed to advise TELUS that:
 - a) TELUS has satisfactorily completed its consultation with the CRD;
 - b) The CRD is satisfied with TELUS's public consultation process and does not require any further consultation with the public; and
 - c) The CRD concurs with TELUS's proposal to construct a wireless telecommunications facility provided it is constructed substantially in accordance with the plans submitted to the CRD.
