That a policy be drafted for inclusion in the nominations package which specifically states that campaigning is not permitted in conjunction with Cariboo Regional District services and/or staff, or in a way that could be perceived as CRD supported.

Further to the above request, a draft of the attached Election Campaigning Location Restriction Policy is now presented for consideration of the Board. Due to timing constraints and obtaining a legal opinion, we were unable to include this policy in the nominations package for this year's upcoming elections. However, we could include it in the letter to candidates if the Board adopts it today.
