### **Short Summary:**

Horsefly Community Hall CWF Water Well Project and Enabling Agreement

### Voting:

Corporate Vote – Weighted

### **Memorandum:**

The Horsefly Community Club has requested a Community Works funding grant of up to \$10,000 to drill a new well and improve the water system at the Horsefly Community Hall.

The Horsefly Community Hall's present water supply is from a dug well on an adjacent property not owned by the Community Club. This well cannot supply sufficient water to meet demand when major events are held at the hall and it often requires more than 24 hours for the well to completely recover. A new well would replace this current water supply and is expected to more ably meet the hall's water demands.

Because the community hall is not owned by the CRD, a contribution agreement between the Regional District and the Horsefly Community Club is required for this project by UBCM under its Gas Tax Sharing Master Agreement with the federal government. Under the terms of the agreement, the community group is responsible for managing the project, maintaining financial records, reporting on measurable results and retaining ownership of the asset for a minimum of 10 years.

### **Financial Implications:**

The proposal from the Horsefly Community Club requests up to \$10,000 from the Community Hall Improvements envelope of the 2018 CWF program.

The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2018, including the Community Hall Improvements envelope which has a total of \$150,000 available. If this application from the

Horsefly Community Club is approved, \$10,000 will be committed through the Community Hall Improvements envelope, leaving a balance of \$135,300 available for community hall projects.

# **Policy Implications:**

None. The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2018, including the Community Hall Improvements envelope. This project meets CWF criteria for developing drinking water systems.
