Short Summary:

UBCM – Group Insurance for Elected Officials

Voting:

Corporate Vote - Unweighted

Memorandum:

The Union of British Columbia Municipalities provides optional Group Insurance coverage for elected officials. Participation in the optional insurance programs through UBCM is contingent upon a minimum of three participants, all of whom must select the same basket of coverage options. The cost of insurance premiums for the optional programs would require payment directly by elected officials, or, would require an increase in administration budget(s) if taxpayer funded. A copy of the UBCM memo regarding group insurance for elected officials is attached to this agenda item.

Cariboo Regional District elected officials currently have 24 hour coverage for Accidental Death and Dismemberment. Also attached to this agenda item is a schedule of benefits currently provided under this policy.
