The 2017 Grant for Assistance for \$5,000 was divided between two projects in Likely; Desktop computer for Cedar City Museum and support toward the building of an Outdoor Learning Centre on the Likely School ground. The computer was purchased for Cedar City Museum in early 2017 but due to the 2017 wildfire season the work on the outdoor learning center was delayed until 2018.

The Cedar City Museum staff are very pleased with the new computer and operating system but are still adjusting to the differences. Most recently, the staff has met with a former museum curator and Kamloops Museum curator and archivist on how to most efficiently use the computer to track archives and museum exhibits. The computer has been a great new asset to the museum.

The Outdoor Learning Centre structure has most recently been completed and will have a dedication ceremony in the spring. The school is looking forward to using the area as an outdoor classroom once the tables are in place. I have also spoken with one member of the Soda Creek Indian Band and she is looking forward to bringing elders out in the future to speak with the children in the Learning Centre.

The new computer, printer and software cost \$1, 116.45 and was paid for in June 2017 and the Outdoor Learning Centre cost \$\$12,941.20. The contractor's fees for the construction of the learning centre were paid in December 2018. Funding for the Outdoor Learning Centre was also provided by Robin Zirnhelt – ISL Engineering and the Robin Hood Memorial Grant – BC Community Forest Association. Recognition of the 2017 grant funding for the computer at the Cedar City Museum was at the Likely Chamber of Commerce 2017 AGM and the funding support towards the Learning Centre will be in a future edition of the Likely Matters as well as at the dedication ceremony in the spring.
