This bylaw is being brought forward for adoption following the applicants meeting Interior Health Authority requirements, obtaining a Provincial Public Highway Commercial Access Permit from the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure. The previous condition of a covenant to ensure compliance with the CRD Shoreland Management Policy with respect to sewage disposal system and riparian protection, has been waived as the Crown already had a covenant requirement when granting the lease.
