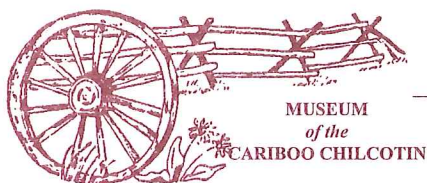
This item has subsequently been referred to the January 23, 2019 Central Cariboo / City of Williams Lake Joint Committee meeting for consideration.
