- 1. The club continues to develop, operate, maintain and provide improvements to the trail network in the Williams Lake area by:
 - a. Supporting the Boys and Girls Club (Sprockids) day rides.
 - b. Putting in thousands of volunteer and professional crew hours on the Desous Mountain Trail Network and Campsite, completing *Phase Two with the Rural Dividend Fund*, and volunteer contributions and matching of funds.
 - c. Spending \$13,000 on trail improvements to continue building world-class trail networks.
 - d. Continuing an ongoing liaison with Recreation Sites and Trails BC.
 - e. Assisting the Williams Lake Indian Band with the Chief William Trail rebuild.
- 2. Expenditure of funds as detailed in the maintenance plan for the trails network in the Williams Lake area for the aforementioned. Further, funds were expended on:
 - a. Phase Five signage, including a kiosk at the entry and egress points of the Tourism Discovery Trail and at different points within that specific network.
 - b. Beginning and implementing trail rebuilds either damaged and/or destroyed by wildfires, in conjunction with the Williams Lake Indian Band.
 - c. The Grand Reopening of the Williams Lake Bike Park in Boitano Park.
 - d. Assisting the City of Williams Lake and the Cariboo Mountain Bike Consortium (CMBC) with the release of the 2018 marketing video held at the Limelight Venue.
- 3. Payment of liability insurance, with coverage of claims up to, and including \$3,000,000, naming both the Cariboo Regional District and the City of Williams Lake as additionally insured on all policies.
