Willoughby Place Streetlighting Service

Memorandum:

Resolution 2018-12-57 was passed at the December 8, 2018 Cariboo Regional District Board meeting as follows:

That the agenda item summary from Alice Johnston, Manager of Corporate Services/Deputy CAO, dated November 15, 2018, regarding a request from Director Delainey to establish a new streetlighting service for Willoughby Place, off of Dog Creek Road, be received. Further, that funds be authorized to undertake a feasibility study with regard to a proposed streetlighting service in this area.

Environmental Services staff contacted BC Hydro to determine capital and operating costs for the proposed streetlighting service. Based on BC Hydro records, the required hydro pole and transformers are already installed at this location and addition of a streetlight to the pole at the end of Willoughby Place could be installed at no charge. Estimated operating costs are in the order of \$250 per year based on current BC Hydro rates.

The proposed service area is comprised of the five (5) parcels that have frontage on Willoughby Place.
