2019 Community Emergency Preparedness Fund – CRD Supports Flood Mapping Application

Memorandum:

Fraser Basin Council is coordinating an approach to complete a flood risk assessment for the entire Thompson River Watershed along with the consulting firm, BGC Engineering Inc. The portion of mapping area for the Cariboo Regional District within the Thompson River Watershed is 10% with a cost estimate of \$25,000. CRD will be applying for the full funding amount of \$150,000.

CRD is working in collaboration with Fraser River Basin Council and adjoining regional districts on this flood mapping project. Staff will explore opportunities to complete flood mapping studies for other areas outside of the Thompson River Watershed within the Cariboo Regional District with the remaining available amount of \$125,000.
