Short Summary:

Request from Interior Health for Financial Recruitment Incentives

Memorandum:

Interior Health has actively been trying to recruit nurses to assist with the shortage of nursing staff at Cariboo Memorial Hospital (CMH) that has resulted in the shutdown of maternity services at this hospital. Interior Health is in need of extra nurses at CMH from April 1st to mid/end of May to address this issue but has been unable to entice nurses to leave their home communities and relocate on a temporary basis.

A financial incentive of \$250/week per nurse could be the difference in maternity services being offered in Williams Lake for those six to eight weeks. This item is included at late publishing due to the time sensitivity of the subject matter and is presented for the Board to discuss and consider carefully.
