Short Summary:

Cariboo Regional District Kersley Fire Protection Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5186, 2018 AAP

Voting:

Corporate Vote - Unweighted

Memorandum:

The Board gave three readings to Cariboo Regional District Kersley Fire Protection Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5186, 2018 on December 7, 2018, and the Bylaw has subsequently received Statutory Approval from the Deputy Inspector of Municipalities. Pursuant to the *Community Charter* and *Local Government Act*, the Board may now proceed with the public assent process. Staff recommend the Alternative Approval Process (AAP), which was discussed during the budget discussions at the end of 2018.

If AAP is chosen, the Board must establish a deadline for receiving elector response forms, which must be at least 30 days after the second public notice is published. When establishing the date, the Board should keep in mind that if 10% or more electors sign an elector response form during the AAP and the Board decides to proceed to an assent vote (referendum), the vote must be held within 80 days of the deadline established for the AAP.

The Board must also establish the elector response forms and make a fair determination of the total number of electors in the AAP area. These documents are attached for the Board's consideration of endorsement.

Financial Implications:

Estimated costs for referendum and alternative approval process with associated communication costs are provided in the table below. An alternative approval process saves approximately \$4,000 in costs.
