Dear South Cariboo Joint Committee,

Re: 2018 Operating Subsidy
South Cariboo Recreation Centre

The year-end financial statement for 2018 has been finalized and we are very pleased to report that our expenses finished lower than our revenues for this past year. Our total revenue for 2018 was \$419,540, with our expenses being \$405,417, a positive variance of \$14,124.

Our revenue was slightly higher than budget by \$326 variance. The main contributors to

the variance being:

Dry Floor Rental \$3,803 Community Programs \$1,860

Canlan Camps \$397 Vending & Other \$3,333

Rec Passes \$2,592

The ice contracts were up a small amount but there was significate growth in our Community Programs, vending & other revenues. There was a small decrease in our spot ice and in our youth leagues due to the lower registration numbers. With the persistence of staff and the growth of users from outside the recreation boundary, there was an increase in rec passes that were sold.

Phone: 250-395-1353 Fax: 250-395-1357 With the revenues lower in programs we focused on managing our costs. The 2018 expenses finished with a variance of \$1,690 with some savings coming from:

Camp Canlan (\$2,748) Marketing staffing (\$4,766) Admin (\$8,656)

Our expenses for 2018 were higher than budgeted due to some unforeseen repairs in Operations. In saying that we were able to meet and exceed on all our monthly facility audits, as well as passing our Corporate audit that was done in August. Our FAME program is updated and used continuously to manage and maintain all the facilities assets. Here are some of the areas where we did not hit our budgeted targets;
