The CRD's submission to UBCM's CRI program has now been reviewed by their Technical Review Committee. The Committee is providing the CRD an opportunity to revise our application to scope it more appropriately and have directed us to work with the BC Wildfire Service (BCWFS).

In subsequent conversations with BCWFS, it has been determined that the areas with the highest risk in the most densely populated areas are in the Lac La Hache and 100 Mile Fringe Areas. They did not endorse our suggestion to encompass the entirety of the South Cariboo as they feel the scope is still too large.
