### **CAO Comments:**

Director Sjostrom has been engaged on this issue since the change in traffic pattern due to the engineering review of the Johnston Street Bridge by the City of Quesnel. The review, and

subsequent load restriction have re-routed industrial traffic to Maple Drive. As Maple Drive does not have streetlighting there is some concern for the safety of the neighborhood. The feasibility request should include both the staff time to explore and develop a plan for streetlighting as well as any costs for a potential assent process. Our initial look indicates that an allocation of up to \$7,500.00 would be sufficient.

The Board should note that this project was not part of the 2019 Business Plan and will result in an incremental increase in the workload for staff. Moving forward, we should attempt to specify new service possibilities and build them into the appropriate Business Plans. There will be significant work to be done on this service proposal, especially if/when we move into the required assent provisions.
