Short Summary: Results of Willoughby Place Streetlighting Establishment Petition

Memorandum:

At its February 8, 2019 meeting, the Cariboo Regional District Board resolved as follows:

That the agenda item summary from Peter Hughes, Manager of Environmental Services, dated January 31, 2019, regarding a proposed streetlighting service for Willoughby Place, be received and that staff be requested to undertake a petition to establish the service.

Staff conducted a petition as directed, which involved a service area comprised of five residences. Petitions went out in early March and the deadline was set as April 12th. In order for the petition to pass, a minimum of 50% of the properties must consent and those properties must represent at least 50% of the net taxable value in the proposed service area. In this case, we only received two petitions (40%) back, and those two properties represented 45% of the net assessed value in the proposed service area.
