The proceeds for the Horsefly Volunteer Fire Department (HVFD) 2019 Grant for Assistance were used for a variety of projects. All funds were spent on training and the training facility at HVFD

Horsefly had 5 fire fighters attend the 150 Mile House Training session in early May. HVFD really appreciates that our members are able to attend this session and find it is challenging and educational. Also very good for networking with fire fighters from other departments. Lots of great ideas are exchanged.

HVFD had two members take the First Responder Instructor course held in Quesnel March 9 and 10, 2019. This will enable us to train and refresh our crews in house, which will result in a significant cost saving.

HVFD is constructing a training building at our compound in Horsefly. The building is 75% complete now and is used for practice every Tuesday. In this building we practice "real life emergency situations" and it is excellent for training. Actually doing a task makes a stronger impression than talking about it or having a "fake" set up. Examples are ladder practice, moving patients up and down stairs, confined space escape, falling through the floor, roof procedures, forcible entry, etc. etc.

Our application had indicated that we would purchase two sets of turnout gear in 2019. Our volunteers have embarked on an aggressive physical fitness program which has resulted in a significant change in their clothing size. The decision was made to hold off on the purchase of the turn out gear until the fitness program is complete.

HVFD us very grateful for the Grant for Assistance that makes it possible for us to purchase the important equipment and to advance the training program.


