NDIT Festival Grant Application – Bridge Lake Fall Fair

#### **Memorandum:**

For the Board's consideration, please find attached an application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Bridge Lake Fall Fair Society. The request is for \$2,500 in grant funding under the Fabulous Festivals and Events Program.

This is the 61<sup>st</sup> year of the Bridge Lake Fair, which is held at the Interlakes Community Centre in August. To preserve heritage traditions, the event offers classes in baking, vegetables, and fine arts as well as demonstrations in spinning along with music, games, races and an afternoon tea.

Other funding for the project, which has a total value of \$7,275 has been proposed to come from the applicant in the form of event revenues.

Prior to forwarding the proposal to the NDIT for Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) consideration, all applications to the Regional Development accounts require a resolution of support from the local government with jurisdiction in the project.
