BYLAW NO. 5232

A bylaw of the Cariboo Regional District, in the Province of British Columbia, to amend the Interlakes Area Fire Protection Service boundaries.

WHEREAS a service area has been established by the Cariboo Regional District by Bylaw No. 4405, cited as “Cariboo Regional District Interlakes Area Fire Protection Service Establishment Bylaw No. 4405, 2008”, and amendments thereto;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act*, a Board may, by bylaw, amend establishment bylaws;

AND WHEREAS, the Board of the Cariboo Regional District has been petitioned by owners of properties who wish to be part of the Interlakes Area Fire Protection Service Area;

AND WHEREAS the Board has deemed it in the interest of providing good government to expand the boundaries of the Interlakes Area Fire Protection Service to include the subject properties;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Cariboo Regional District, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Title

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “Interlakes Area Fire Protection Service Boundary Amendment Bylaw No. 5232, 2019”.

Schedule “A”, as referred to in Section 2 of Bylaw No. 4405, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by Schedule “A”, attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
