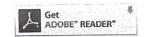

People can enter the following classes: Baking, Vegeteables, fine arts, students and more (see attached program). We have two quilt raffle tables, spinning demonstrations, silent auction, outdoor and indoor music, a cakewalk, childrens games and races, a bouncy castle, outdoor booths, afternoon tea in the hall, horse show and competition and so much more...

The fair maintains a homegrown element that stives to keep old traditions alive while creating new ones.

It promotes a positive sense of well being and community pride in participants by showcasing local talents and products.
