Memorandum:

The Ministry of Agriculture is asking for feedback on proposed changes in the Class D regulation relating to animal slaughter and meat inspection. The original deadline, which was not well known, has passed and the Ministry has set a new date in October to allow for comment. We discovered the consultation very late but did send in a letter (copy attached) after consulting with the BC Cattlemen to make sure they had no real concerns. While we are not experts in this area, we feel that additional opportunities to slaughter and market meat products would be welcome. We also feel that the restriction of marketing within an individual regional district is artificial.

With the extension, the Board has the opportunity to review the information, discuss the matter, and advise staff of how the Board would like to respond.
