2018-2-22

That the Board hereby establishes a moratorium on the approval of any cannabis retail applications in the Cariboo Regional District, until such time as the provincial government provides clear rules for regional districts in this regard.

As we move forward with amendments to our zoning bylaws to allow for cannabis retail applications, it is prudent for the Board to discontinue the moratorium and resolve as such to provide clarity to the public and any potential applicants.
