Please be advised that TELUS has completed the public consultation process, following Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada's, CPC Procedures as it relates the proposed wireless antenna installations in the above noted subject line. TELUS is respectfully requesting, from the Cariboo Regional District Board, concurrence for the proposal to build a self-support structure telecommunication facility in an effort to provide improved TELUS wireless communications services to Forest Grove.

As you are aware, regarding the history with this project, TELUS proposed a tower within town, and it was determined by a majority of the community that the preference would be further from town in this location or a number of other locations identified. TELUS has determined a new location that will technically work to provide better service to the area and the height is required to do so. As such, we have moved forward with this location. It has been received well by a majority of the community because it is well setback from nearby homes, roadways and is located in a forested area to limit view of the tower from nearby homes. We do not expect neighbouring properties to be able to view the tower from their respective homes. The specific location on site was chosen to take advantage of some existing access and because it is a few hundred metres into a forested area to reduce any visibility of the tower.

Enclosed please find evidence of the TELUS' efforts regarding this public consultation process.

On June 25, 2019, an Information Package was submitted to the City of CRD formalizing the initiation of the consultation process with the Regional District. Please see **Appendix 1: Information Package**.

On July 29, 2019, notification packages were mailed to property owners within a radius of three times the tower height (approximately 137.0 metres) to advise them of the proposal. Please see **Appendix 2: Affidavit of Notification Package**.

On August 15, 2019 an advertisement ran in the 100 Mile Free Press, please see **Appendix 3: Newspaper Tear Sheet**.

On August 14, 2019 TELUS held a Public Information Meeting at the Forest Grove Community Centre where 39 people attended, please see **Appendix 4: Meeting Sign-In Sheet**

On September 9, 2019 the consultation period ended. During the consultation period, 46 residents provided comments; 38 were in support, 7 were opposed and 1 was of neutral opinion. Please see Appendix 5: **Comments and Responses Tracker**.

TELUS is committed to providing reliable wireless service to CRD. If the CRD concurs with the proposed wireless communications facility project, please find in **Appendix 6: Sample Resolution**, a sample resolution which may be used. As an alternative Staff may wish to provide concurrence via letter indicating that the consultation process as required by ISED was completed and that the Board have no further outstanding concerns with the proposal. Overview

Cypress Land Services Inc., in our capacity as agents to TELUS, is submitting this information package to formalize the consultation process related to the installation and operation of a telecommunications facility. If you recall, TELUS completed a previous consultation for a proposed tower at the Firehall in Forest Grove. As a result of public concerns, TELUS has proposed to relocate the tower further from the school.

Proposed Site

The subject property is located at 4592 Chuckwagon Trail in Forest Grove, BC. The proposed installation consists of a 45.6 metre self-support tower structure with nine (9) initial panel antennas, three (3) future panel antennas, two (2) future microwave antenna, and a 20m x 20m equipment compound which includes an equipment shelter, genset, transformer and propane tank near the base. The facility is proposed in the southwestern portion of the property with existing driveway at the front of the entrance that needs to be extended towards the southern property line. There is good access/clearance along the southern property line where an access road would need to be constructed to ensure 24/7 access. Please see **Schedule A: Tower Site Location**.

Rationale for Site Selection

TELUS seeks to maintain and improve high quality, dependable network services. In order to improve network performance, TELUS is seeking to add the proposed communications installation to improve service in the Forest Grove area.

The proposed site is a result of many considerations. When a telecommunications carrier is determining a location for new wireless installation it must consider a number of factors to ensure the new installation operates effectively and results in reliable wireless services for the immediate community. Some of the considerations include frequency of operation, local topography, patterns of wireless users, building heights, road patterns, availability of land and existing structures. TELUS investigated the area for collocation options on nearby tower sites and unfortunately there are no nearby structures to utilize. TELUS also completed a previous consultation whereby the proposed site was offered as a viable alternative to the firehall site.

Proposal Details

A 45.6 metre self-support tower is proposed. TELUS has completed preliminary design plans (**Schedule B: Preliminary Plans**). These preliminary design plans are subject to final engineered design, land survey and approval of Transport Canada. Transport Canada approval may require tower lighting and/or marking; comments are pending.

Consultation Process with the Cariboo Regional District

It is our understanding that Cariboo Regional District does not have an adopted Telecommunications policy. Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada, requires all proponents to consult with the local land use authority and public, notwithstanding that ISED has exclusive jurisdiction in the licensing of telecommunication sites, such as the proposed tower. Following ISED's requirements, TELUS would like to initiate Default Public Consultation Process (as described in the Industry Canada circular, CPC-2-0-03, issue 5, commonly referred to as the "CPC"). Information on the "CPC" consultation process may be found on-line at: <http://www.ic.gc.ca/eic/site/smt-gst.nsf/eng/sf08777.html>.

In order to obtain comments, concerns or questions in regard to the proposed tower site, the CPC requires TELUS to send out notification packages to all properties located within three times the height of the proposed tower (approx. 137 metres). A notice will also be placed in the local paper. This comment period is a minimum of 30 days. We expect the public consultation process to commence in July 2019.

At the conclusion of the consultation process, TELUS will prepare a summary of comments received from the community as well as the replies provided by TELUS. TELUS is requesting that, subsequent to the completed consultation process a letter or resolution of concurrence will be issued by the Regional District.

Health and Safety

Health Canada's Safety Code 6 regulations are applicable to this, and all, telecommunications sites. Safety Code 6 seeks to limit the public's exposure to radiofrequency electromagnetic fields and ensures public safety. Additional information on health and safety may be found on-line at:

In order to complete the consultation process, TELUS will be requesting concurrence from the Cariboo Regional District in a form acceptable by ISED.

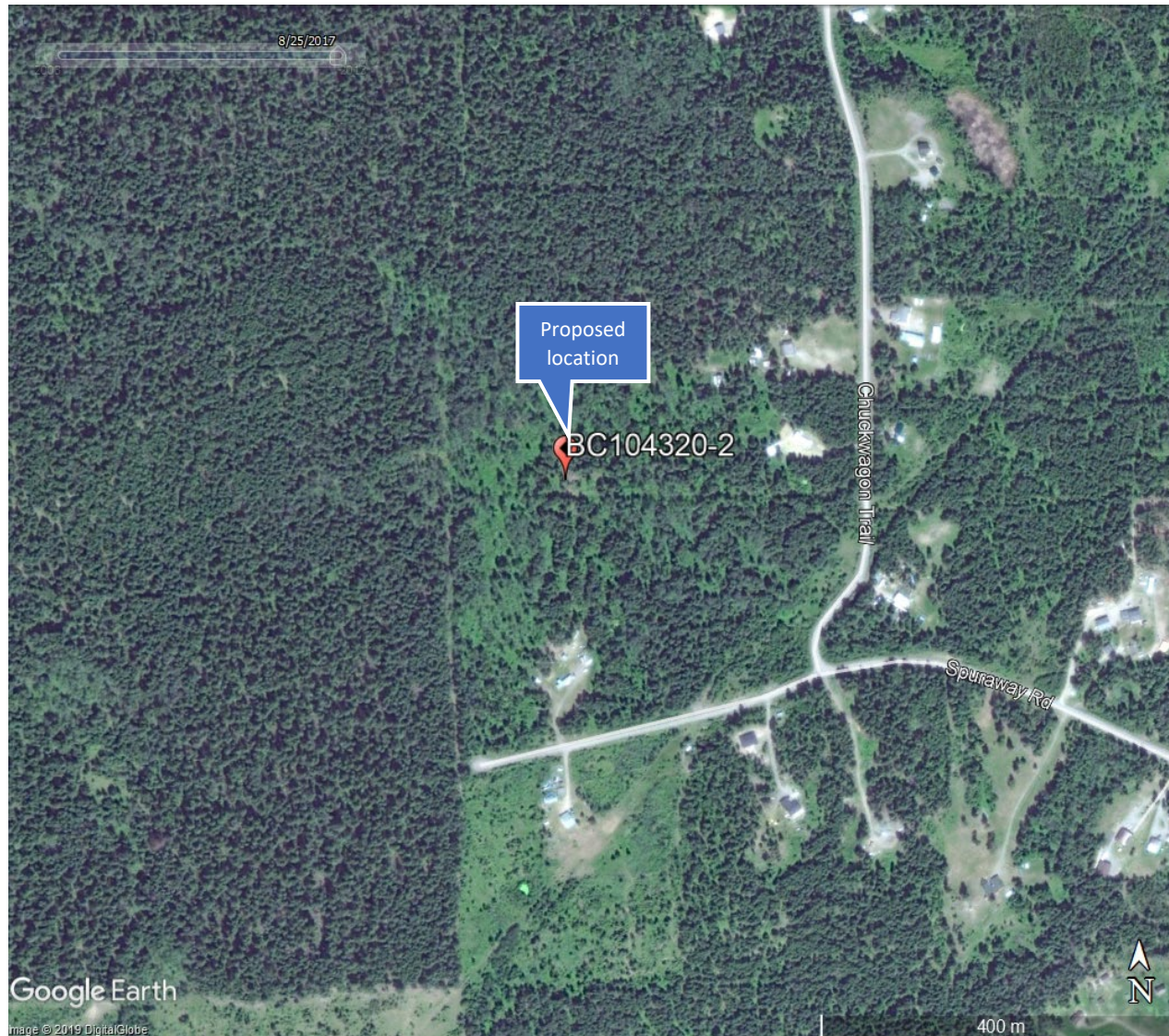

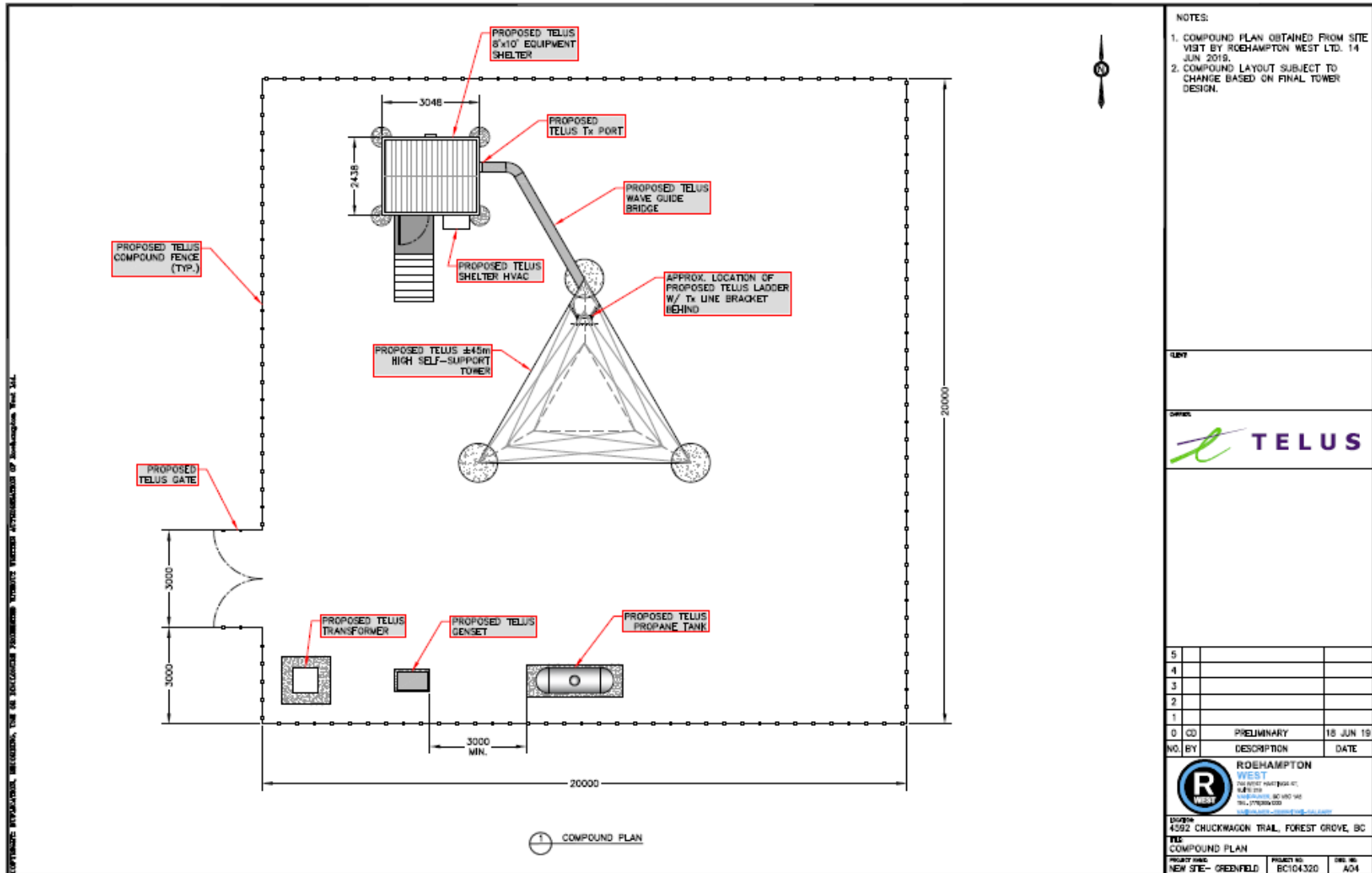
**SCHEDULE A
TOWER SITE LOCATION**



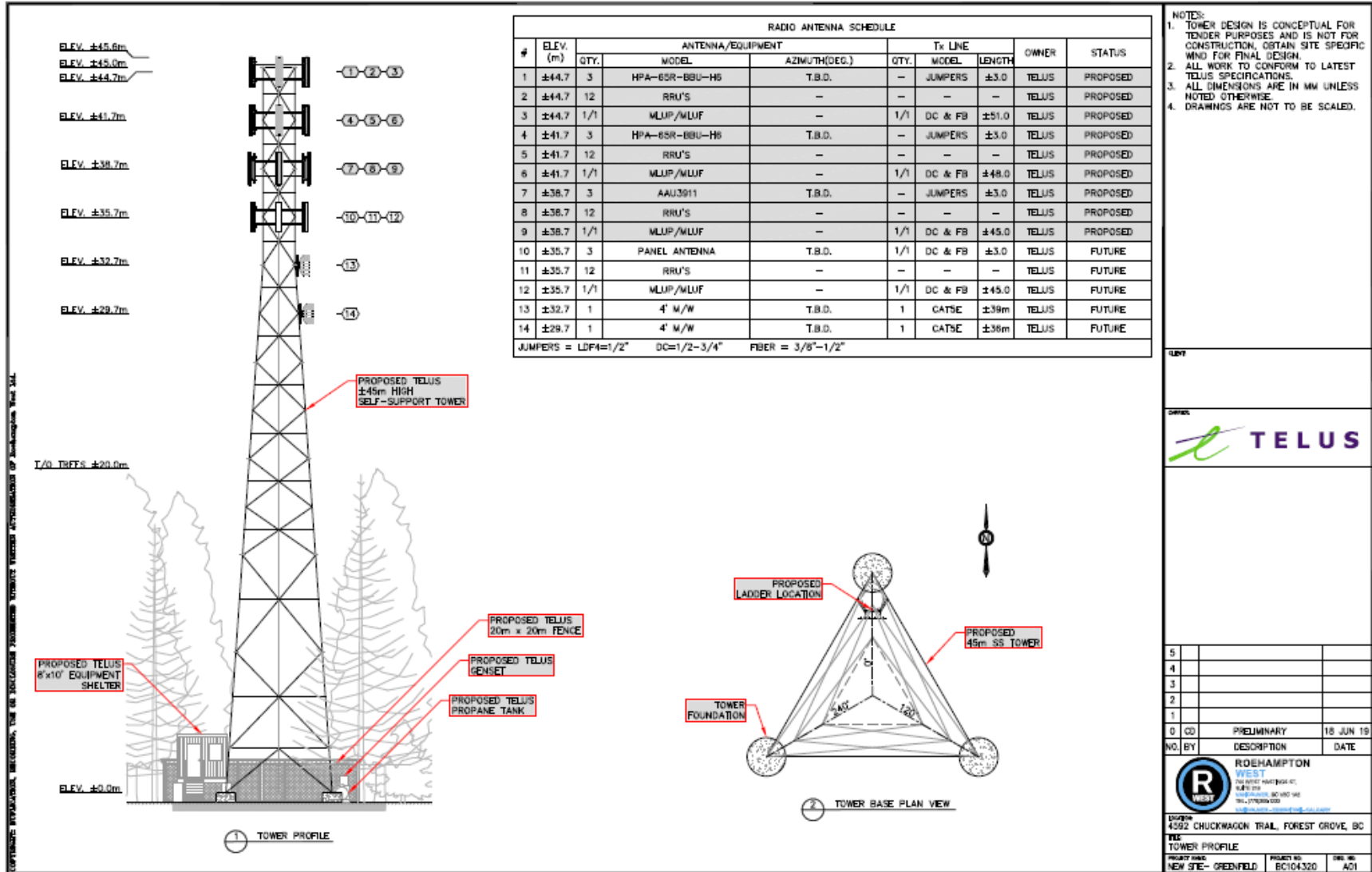



What is TELUS Proposing?

TELUS seeks to continue to provide high quality wireless telecommunications services to Canadians. Increasingly, Canadians depend on wireless voice, data and internet communications for business, personal enjoyment and personal security reasons. In response to demand for improved wireless service in Forest Grove, BC, TELUS is proposing to add a telecommunications facility. **You may recall, TELUS completed a previous consultation for a proposed tower at the Firehall in Forest Grove. As a result of public concerns, TELUS has proposed to relocate the tower further from the school. The subject property is located at 4592 Chuckwagon Trail in Forest Grove, BC. TELUS is proposing to install a 45.6 metre self-support tower structure and fenced equipment compound at the base.**

Regulatory Authority

Telecommunication providers are required by Innovation, Science, and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada, to consult with the local municipality and the general public regarding new installations. ISED does have exclusive jurisdiction over the approval and placement of telecommunications installations.

The consultation process will provide an opportunity for residents, stakeholders and landowners to obtain detailed information regarding the proposal and to provide comments for consideration. Any inquiries that are received as a result of this notification will be logged and submitted to the Cariboo Regional District and ISED as part of our application for concurrence.

The Cariboo Regional District's (CRD) Consultation Process

The CRD does not have a telecommunications policy. Therefore, TELUS will be following the CPC-2-0-03 — Radiocommunication and Broadcasting Antenna Systems client procedures circular, as mandated by Innovation, Science, and Economic Development Canada (ISED). This notification provides an opportunity to obtain information regarding the proposal, ask questions and provide comments. The closing period for comments to be received by TELUS is September 7, 2019. Purpose

A new telecommunications site is proposed to improve wireless internet and cell phone coverage within the Forest Grove area and surrounding roadways. Currently, there are no existing antenna support structures or other feasible infrastructure in the vicinity of the proposed tower that can be utilized to collocate antennas on; as a result, a new antenna support structure is required. TELUS did review a number of other proposed locations and the proposed location would work best to services the areas requirements.

Location

The tower is proposed to be located at the following coordinates: 51.75988° N, -121.12791° W. The land is privately owned. The specific location of the tower is shown in the aerial photo attached.

Safety Code 6

ISED requires all wireless carriers to operate in accordance with Health Canada's safety standards. TELUS confirms that the tower described in this notification package will be installed and operated on an ongoing basis so as to comply with Health Canada's Safety Code 6, as may be amended from time to time.

Design

This proposal is for a 45.6 metre self-support tower structure with nine (9) initial panel antennas, three (3) future panel antennas, two (2) future microwave antenna, and a 20m x 20m equipment compound which includes an equipment shelter, generator, transformer and propane tank near the base. TELUS has completed preliminary design plans which are enclosed.

Site Access

The facility is proposed in the southwestern portion of the property with existing driveway at the front of the entrance that needs to be extended towards the southern property line. There is good access/clearance along the southern property line where an access road would need to be constructed to ensure 24/7 access. Construction is anticipated to take approximately one month.

Environment

TELUS confirms that the installation is excluded from environmental assessment under the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act. Any municipal environmental regulations will be followed.

Transport Canada

The tower will be required to comply with lighting or marking requirements as determined by Transport Canada. Comments are pending.

Structural Considerations

TELUS confirms that the antenna structure described in this notification package will apply good engineering practices including, structural adequacy during construction. The facility will be built to the National Building Code as well as the BC Building Code.

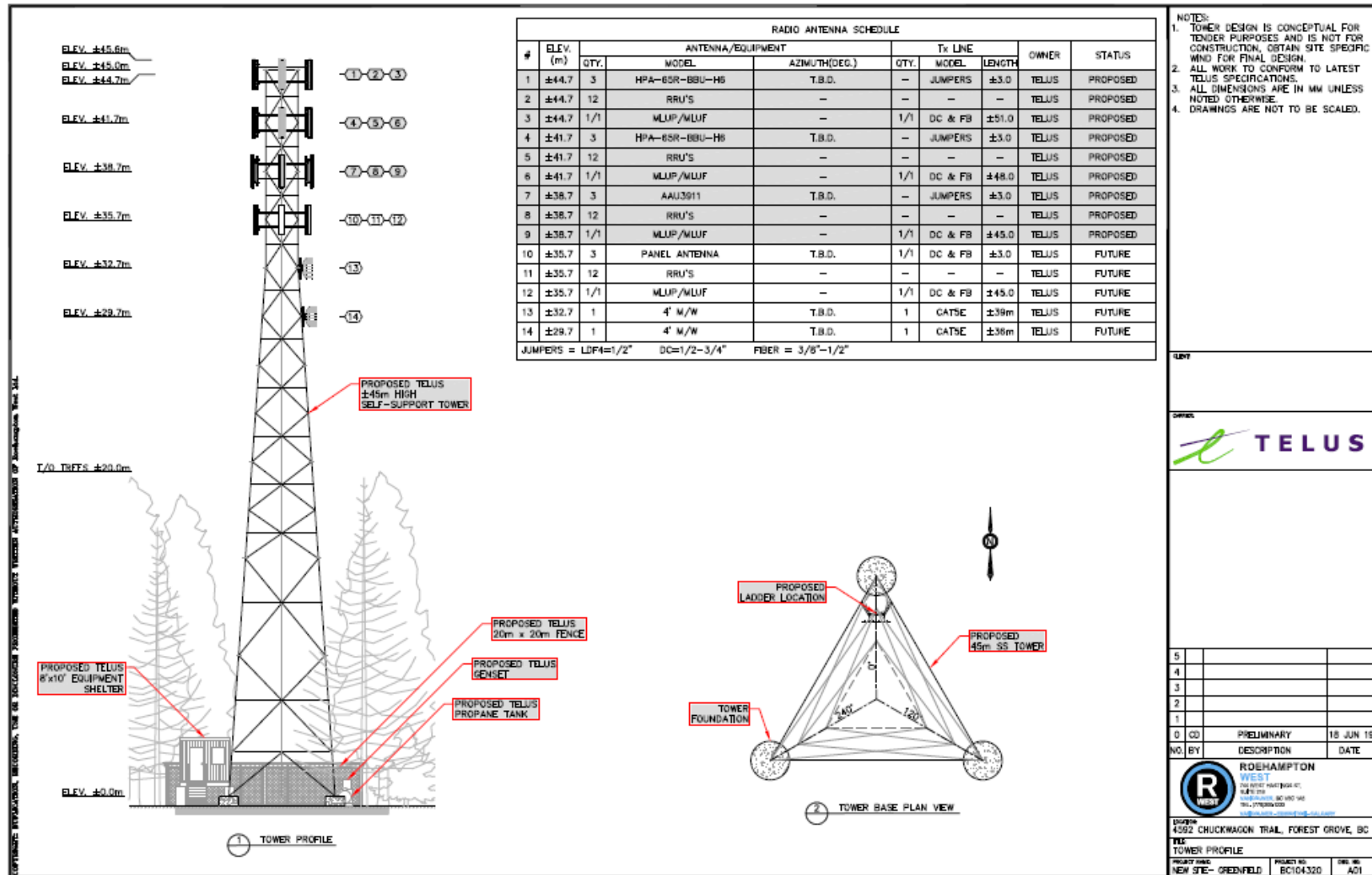

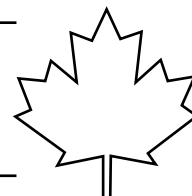

Former B.C. health minister ready to make a return on a federal level

A former British Columbia politician is ready to make a return in hopes to run on a federal level.

Former B.C. health minister Terry Lake is seeking out the federal Liberal nomination for the southern interior riding of Kamloops-Thompson-Cariboo.

"I didn't have plans to go back in but I felt like this is a turn-

ing point for Canada," said Lake, who is quite certain this election will help the country move forward in terms of the policies that have been put in place.

The government has been focusing on the environment, with issues regarding climate change, the reconciliation with the country's indigenous people and the opioid crisis.

These are some of the issues Lake said

he is passionate about.

I wanted to make sure that I had an opportunity to continue work in those areas with the Liberal party on a federal level," said Lake. "I feel they (the government) are on the right track in those areas. I think about the riding we have here in Kamloops-Thompson-Cariboo and having represented Kamloops-North Thompson for eight years in the legislature, I am aware of some

of the critical issues that parts of our riding are facing such as 100 Mile House and Clearwater."

One of the major issues in the South Cariboo is the forest industry. Lake understands how critical this can be to people's economic sustainability and the affected communities.

"I feel with my background in the provincial government, that on a federal level I think I will be able to advocate for these communities and help them through these difficult times," said Lake. "When you look at advocating for the middle-class, the Conservative Party did not vote for the child benefit that has helped many families across the country. I think they tend to have more of the interest

in people who are top one percent rather than the middle-class who makes up the bulk of this country."

Lake felt that the Conservative Party and Andrew Scheer, in particular, are putting a "pause" on certain

policies rather than being progressive. One example he used was the climate change plan which Lake said

has been criticized by any credible environmental economist. According to the Conservative Party of Canada's website, the plan promises to lower greenhouse gas emissions and strengthen environmental protections. That policy was built on three principles: green technology and not taxes, a cleaner and greener natural environment and taking a fight against global climate change.

"I don't think it is a serious plan and that is just going to stall us when we are at a time where we need to make some serious gains in terms of climate action."

Lake believes that by electing a Conservative government, it will set the country back in regards to some of the

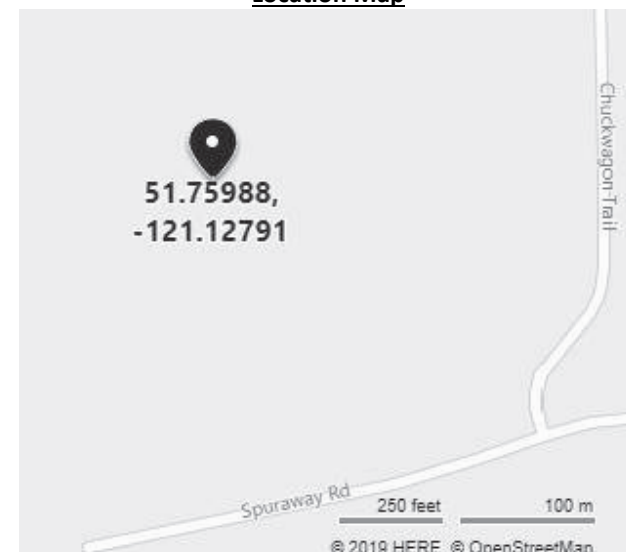

Location Map

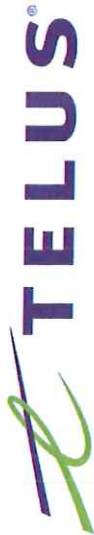

Appendix 6: Sample Resolution

Resolution

WHEREAS TELUS proposes to erect a wireless communications facility at the location of 4592 Chuckwagon Trail, Forest Grove, BC;

AND WHEREAS proponents of telecommunication towers are regulated by Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada (ISED), formerly Industry Canada on behalf of the Government of Canada and as part of their approval, ISED requires proponents to consult with land use authorities as provided for in CPC-2-0-03;

AND WHEREAS TELUS has consulted with the CRD following the CPC-2-0-03 and the CRD planning staff have no objection to the proposed telecommunications tower;

AND WHEREAS TELUS has consulted with the public by notifying properties within three times the tower height, and has provided a 30-day period for written public comment;

AND WHEREAS there are no significant land use issues identified by the consultation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Clerk be instructed to advise TELUS that:
 - a) TELUS has satisfactorily completed its consultation with the CRD;
 - b) The CRD is satisfied with TELUS's public consultation process and does not require any further consultation with the public; and
 - c) The CRD concurs with TELUS's proposal to construct a wireless telecommunications facility provided it is constructed substantially in accordance with the plans submitted to the CRD.
