Please find attached 2 grant requests for financial support through the CRD for 2020 as well as the continuous/yearly grant that I see is now available for an amount less than 1000.00. We would like to be considered for the maximum allowable amount if this option is made available to us..

I have also included our financials provided at our Aug 8, 2019 AGM and our list of expenses for the last 2 access improvement s.

1. Brief Description of Proposed Use of Grant Being Applied For:

This years request for the 2500.00 would be to finish our final access improvement (access 11 on Deka Lake) as well as upgrade the Hathaway parking, small launch and picnic area - keeping users safely off the road. The continuous grant requested of less than 1000.00 per year would be to continue with small and general maintenance all access's for Higgins, Hathaway, Sulphurous and Deka Lakes.

2. How do you know there is a need for this service/project in our community?

Hathaway project is to get users off the road and safe from local traffic during the summer and winter months. Access improvement provides a safe environment for all users who live off the lake, separating boaters and swimmers.
