

Department/Function Services

The Cariboo Regional District facilitates streetlighting for the residents in the Forest Grove area as established by Bylaw No. 37. This service was established in 1971 and is taxed using assessed value of land and improvements; no taxation limitation has been determined by the bylaw. The local service area is illuminated by 31 streetlights.

As the Electoral Area H Director is the only stakeholder, and the *Local Government Act* requires more than one vote, the entire Board is responsible for the governance of this service.

In 2019, BC Hydro rates increased by 1.8%. It is anticipated that rates may increase by 5.2% over the next three years.
