Short Summary:

2020 Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) Application – Flood Mapping

Memorandum:

In 2019, the CRD applied for and received UBCM CEPF funding for our portion of a flood risk assessment coordinated by the Fraser Basin Council for adjoining Regional Districts.

The CRD would like to apply for the 2020 CEPF funding of \$150,000 to build upon the previous years' work. The Fraser Basin Council is coordinating this project as well for adjoining Local Governments.

The work will advance integrated flood and steep creek risk management for multiple jurisdictions in the Thompson River watershed and areas of the Cariboo Regional District in the upper Fraser River watershed. The first phase of the work focused on risk prioritization and screening-level floodplain mapping. This next phase proposes further floodplain mapping and more detailed hazard and risk assessment for high priority areas identified in the first phase of work.
