

TERMS OF REFERENCE

North Cariboo Rural Directors Caucus

The North Cariboo Rural Directors Caucus is comprised of the Cariboo Regional District Directors for Electoral Areas A, B, C, and I.

The Caucus creates an opportunity for informal discussions of issues that will affect, or have the potential to affect, the greater North Cariboo area.

The Caucus may provide recommendations to the North Cariboo Joint Committee or the Cariboo Regional District Board.

There shall be one Chair and one Vice-Chair appointed from and by the caucus members at the first meeting each year.

A quorum is defined as a majority of the Directors (3).

The Caucus will operate on a general consensus basis. However, a single member may oppose a resolution and be recorded in the minutes as such. If two members oppose a resolution then it is agreed that consensus has not been achieved and the resolution cannot proceed as a recommendation of the caucus. In this case, the item may be deferred to a future caucus meeting or may be referred directly to the Regional District Board without a caucus recommendation.
