Cariboo Regional District Deka Lake Fire Protection Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5236, 2019

## Memorandum:

The Cariboo Regional District conducted an Alternative Approval Process for the Deka Lake Fire Protection Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 5236, 2019. The number of elector responses required to prevent the CRD from proceeding without a referendum was estimated to be 98 (10% of the electors in the service area). As you will see in the attached Certificate of Elector Response Results, no elector response forms were received, and the Board may therefore proceed with adoption of the bylaw.
