## **Short Summary:**

South Cariboo Transit Agreement Renewal with the District of 100 Mile House

#### **Voting:**

By consensus

#### Memorandum:

The Cariboo Regional District (Region) has a contribution agreement with the District of 100 Mile House (District) to support public transit services in the south Cariboo. The District holds the cost-sharing agreement with BC Transit, which is renewed on an annual basis.

The service includes custom paratransit for 100 Mile House, 108 Mile Ranch and the southern portion of Lac La Hache (on a limited basis). The South Cariboo Transit function reflects the service area with an annual requisition from this portion of Electoral Area G.

The local government cost share is split between the Region and the District with 50% each and the remainder of the net operating costs is covered by BC Transit. Total cost of the service is approximately \$375,000 per year.

Annual ridership is approximately 13,780 passengers per year.

#### **Financial Implications:**

Costs for the contribution agreement are allocated in the South Cariboo Transit function and range from \$56,308 in 2020 to an estimated \$63,456 in 2024 accounting for annual inflationary increases.

## **Policy Implications:**

None. There will be an RFP procurement process for the transit system operator contract in 2020 and this will be handled by BCT and the District.
