On March 6th, 2020, an AIS was presented to the Board seeking a resolution in support of an application to UBCM for the 2020 Community Emergency Preparedness Fund in regard to Emergency Operations Centers and Training Program in the amount of \$19,096. This grant would be applied to upgrading existing IT assets in the EOC as well as for new equipment to increase capacity. This request was approved and assigned resolution number 2020-3A-13.

We have received confirmation that our application is approved in principle, but requires an additional resolution indicating support for the proposed project and willingness to provide overall grant management. Staff has completed this function for several years and management and application of this grant is not an administrative burden.
