Community Works Funds for Capital Purchasing of COVID-19 Protection at Recreation Centres **Voting:**

Corporate Vote - Weighted

Memorandum:

As restrictions issued by the provincial and regional health authorities are reduced, core recreation facilities of the Cariboo Regional District are preparing re-opening plans and procedures to ensure safe operations for the public and staff.

Several capital purchases and upgrades will be necessary to open the South Cariboo Recreation Centre in 100 Mile House, the Cariboo Memorial Recreation Complex in Williams Lake and the Quesnel and District Arts and Recreation Centre and Arenas in Quesnel.

Key components of these COVID-19 safety projects will include permanent protection barriers along front counters and the purchase of disinfecting mist equipment to effectively and efficiently treat high traffic areas in locker rooms and fitness gyms.

Similar to the reopening plans for the Regional District libraries and administrative offices, staff propose utilizing Community Works Funds for these capital projects.

It is expected that once the recreation centres reopen there will be a significant imbalance of lower revenues from restricted operations, combined with an increased cost from additional safety measures, such as cleaning and controls.

Accessing Community Works Funds for these capital items will assist the facilities to continue to meet the 2020 target budget as planned.

Financial Implications:

The estimated cost to install protective barriers at all three facilities and purchase three disinfecting mist machines with sufficient initial treatment chemical is approximately \$40,000.

Policy Implications:

The proposal is consistent with the Regional District COVID-19 Response Plan, as well as functional guidance from Worksafe BC and provincial health authorities.
