### Memorandum:

The Board gave Bylaw No. 5239 three readings on August 23, 2019. Subsequent to that, the bylaw received statutory approval from the Deputy Inspector of Municipalities and can now be considered for adoption. The Board previously received several letters of both opposition and support for this project:

The attached letter was received after the previous correspondence was presented to the Board, so is included on today's agenda.

During consideration of this item, the Board should be aware that there is another available option to the residents that wish to have parking available. Those people could either form a society or apply as an individual to the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development for tenure over available Crown Land in the area to use for a parking lot. This process involves public advertising and a public meeting. If they form a society, they may qualify for nominal rent tenure.
