Memorandum:

The Deka Lake VFD outfitted a donated boat many years ago to assist them in providing fire suppression on the water, to watercraft or properties with water access only. Due to legislated requirements in the operation of boats, the high costs of continued training in water emergency operations, and the additional costs of water PPE, it became clear that the VFD was no longer able to maintain this service. There have been little to no emergency response calls for this type of service. There is only one property that is impacted by the withdrawal of this service, and those owners have been contacted. Bylaw No. 5283 seeks to reduce the boundary by removing this property from the service area.
