SCHEDULE "K"

FIRE TRAINING CENTRE

Preamble

- A) The City operates a Fire Training Centre that is shared by Regional District Volunteer Fire Departments.
- B) The City operates a Sprinkler Protection Unit that is shared by Regional District Volunteer Fire Departments.
- C) The Regional District and the City would benefit in the form of improved safety and training for firefighters from an agreement for the shared expenses of the Fire Training Centre and Sprinkler Protection Unit;

Term

1. This Agreement is for a term as identified in the Master Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the Regional District.

Intent

2. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to continue to develop and expand a framework of cooperation between the City of Quesnel and Cariboo Regional District to develop an Emergency Fire Training Facility for the North Cariboo Fire Departments.

Services

- 3. The fire departments who will participate in the use of the Fire Training Facilities are the City of Quesnel and the following Cariboo Regional District Fire Departments: Kersley, West Fraser, Bouchie Lake, Ten Mile and Barlow Creek.
- 4. The City must create and maintain books, accounts and records relating to the Fire Training Centre and this agreement. The books, accounts and records must be kept by the City in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.
- 5. The parties agree that each department will contribute an annual contribution of \$2,500 per department which will be managed by the City. This annual contribution will be strictly used for Capital projects.
- 6. The City of Quesnel Fire Department is the main user of the Fire Training Centre and therefore will oversee all maintenance and renovation aspects for the facilities.

- 7. The City of Quesnel will ensure that the Cariboo Regional District is consulted and informed before any capital projects are approved.
- 8. The Northern Sprinkler Protection Trailer will now be part of the Fire Training Centre.
- 9. The City of Quesnel Fire Department will ensure that a minimum standard of equipment is maintained in the Sprinkler Protection trailer at all times. Funding for the purchase of equipment will come from the Capital account.
- 10. The Cariboo Regional District will cover the cost of insurance for each year for the Sprinkler Protection Unit trailer and provide the license plate decal to the City of Quesnel Fire Department.
- 11. Each contributing fire department will be assigned a dedicated training evening as follows:

Quesnel – Tuesday night
Kersley – Wednesday night
West Fraser – Wednesday night
Barlow Creek – Wednesday night
Ten Mile – Wednesday night
Bouchie Lake – Thursday night

- 12. The City of Quesnel Fire Department will oversee all booking for the use of the fire training facilities by external agencies.
- 13. All revenues from external agencies will be directed into the capital account.

Inclusion

- 14. This agreement covers the following departments:
 - a) City of Quesnel
 - b) West Fraser
 - c) Barlow Creek
 - d) Ten Mile
 - e) Bouchie Lake
 - f) Kersley

Termination

- 15. Notwithstanding the provisions of the termination of the Master Agreement, should either party fail to meet its commitments under this Schedule:
 - (a) the other party that has not failed to meet its commitments may give notice to the party in breach of this Schedule of its failure to perform;
 - (b) should the party in breach of this Schedule fail to meet its commitments within ninety (90) days of such notice from the other party, then in that event the other party may terminate this Schedule without any compensation of any kind to the breaching party.
