

Pioneer Park

Low mobility Trail & site improvements



Pioneer Park is owned by the CRD & the city of Quesnel. The park land was donated by the Cariboo Farmers institute and the Dragon Lake Women’s institute in 1988. The park was donated for recreational purposes and for the enjoyment of the community.

Pioneer Park is also home to, two none profit organizations, Quesnel River Archers, and the Dragon Lake Paddlers. The Quesnel River Archers hold a variety of archery competitions annually and are recognized as the care takers of since 1995. The Dragon Lake paddlers also have gate access, and utilize the road highlighted in purple to access their boat storage building on the shores of Dragon Lake.

Improve existing trails to Whistler Type III –\$15,300

- Approx. 1275 meters (\$12/meter) – \$15,300
- plan as unsurfaced single-track trail
- may be machine built
- clear width to 1.1-1.3 m
- clear height to 2.4 m
- provide 50-70 cm tread width on native soil
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New trail construction whistler Type III: \$12,200

- Approx. 610 meters (\$20/meter) – \$12,200
- plan as unsurfaced single-track trail
- Hand or Machine machine built- mini excavator.
- clear width to 1.1-1.3 m
- clear height to 2.4 m
- provide 50-70 cm tread width on native soil

Benches/Outhouses/Lookouts/Gates: 12,000

- 1 Low mobility outhouses - 2000
- 2 Regular outhouses -2000
- 2 decommission outhouses -2000
- 1 look out platforms -1000
