

2021 Business Plan Copper Ridge Streetlighting (1446)

Working in partnership with communities large and small to offer local, sub-regional and regional services to ensure that the Cariboo Chilcotin is a socially, economically and environmentally desirable region.

Department/Function Services

The Cariboo Regional District facilitates streetlighting for the residents on Copper Ridge Road in Quesnel as established by Bylaw No. 4539. This service was established in 2009 and is taxed by way of a parcel tax. The taxation limitation for 2010 was \$858, or an amount recovered by applying a tax rate of \$1.1557/\$1,000 to the net taxable value of land and improvements, and for 2011 and beyond is \$200, or an amount recovered by applying a tax rate of \$.2694/\$1,000 to the net taxable value of lands and improvements. The local service area is illuminated by one streetlight.

As the Electoral Area A Director is the only stakeholder, and the *Local Government Act* requires more than one vote, the entire Board is responsible for the governance of this service.



Business Plan Goals, Rationale & Strategies

Overall Financial Impact

The 2021 requisition has been increased in anticipation of BC Hydro switching to LED lights. Cost is expected to be \$1.57 per light per month.

Significant Issues & Trends

In 2019, BC Hydro rates increased by 1.8%. It is anticipated that rates may increase by 5.2% over the next three years.

The Cariboo Regional District is a signatory on the Province of BC/UBCM Climate Action Charter and has committed to continuing work towards carbon neutrality in respect of corporate operations.
