Short Summary:

Cariboo Regional District Maple Drive Streetlighting Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5280, 2020

Voting:

Corporate Vote - Unweighted

Memorandum:

The Board gave three readings to Cariboo Regional District Maple Drive Streetlighting Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5280, 2020 on July 10, 2020, and the Bylaw has subsequently received Statutory Approval from the Deputy Inspector of Municipalities. The Board may now proceed with a public assent process; the Electoral Area Director has expressed an interest in conducting an Alternative Approval Process (AAP) as the information has already been shared publicly through various means, and to keep the costs low.

If AAP is chosen, the Board must establish a deadline for receiving elector response forms, which must be at least 30 days after the second public notice is published. When establishing the date, the Board should keep in mind that if 10% or more electors sign an elector response form during the AAP and the Board decides to proceed to an assent vote (referendum), the vote must be held within 80 days of the deadline established for the AAP.

The Board must also establish the elector response forms and make a fair determination of the total number of electors in the AAP area. These documents are attached for the Board's consideration of endorsement.

Financial Implications:

Obtaining public assent through an AAP process saves significantly over the cost of conducting a referendum.

#2: That the Cariboo Regional District Board authorizes the Elector Response Form as attached hereto for the Cariboo Regional District Maple Drive Streetlighting Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5280, 2020 Alternative Approval Process, which allows for a single elector response on each form, and which may be accepted by email or facsimile provided it is an accurate copy of the original form.

#3: That the Cariboo Regional District Board has determined that 1,112 represents the total number of eligible electors for the Alternative Approval Process with respect to Cariboo Regional District Maple Drive Streetlighting Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5280, 2020.

#4: That the Cariboo Regional District Board has established November 16, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. as the deadline for receiving elector responses for the Cariboo Regional District Maple Drive Streetlighting Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5280, 2020 Alternative Approval Process.
