#### **ADAC Strategic Plan**

Since its establishment in 2018, the Agricultural Development Advisory Committee has moved forward its top 3 strategic plan recommendations:

- Regional Food & Innovation Hub
- Agriculture Education Program
- Agriculture Area Plan

#### **Regional Food & Innovation Hub**

- A location for the Sprout Kitchen has been selected
- City of Quesnel council has authorized the a fiveyear lease agreement for the 2,689 square foot space
- ■Initial stages of start up in the spring of 2021

- Most components of the program have been implemented and are 70-100% complete
- Program completion impacted by COVID-19
- → A request for an extension to December 14,2021

#### **Agriculture Area Plan**

- ADAC is gathering information from various Ministries & agencies:
  - ➤ Quesnel District Land Management
  - ➤ Ministry of Forestry
  - ➤ Social Development and Poverty Reduction's Labour Market Partnership
  - ➤ Ministry of Agriculture Labour Market update
- broaden our understanding of the ongoing work, opportunities and challenges
- impact on agriculture

#### **CCBAC Agriculture Sector Strategy**

- Includes detailed strategies for agriculture development
- Many changes since the report was published



#### **CCBAC Agriculture Sector Strategy**

- Implementation of some of the recommendations in the report have occurred:
  - ➤ Increased support from local and provincial governments including the extension services provided by the Ministry of Agriculture;
  - ➤ Build up of infrastructure such as the Regional Food Hub and Agriculture Event Centre; and
  - ➤ The formation of the Agricultural Development Advisory Committee

#### **Agriculture Industry**

- Some of the issues that still need to be addressed:
  - ➤ The lack of finishing and processing facilities in the beef industry
  - The shortage of skilled labour and training
  - > Utilizing technology to increase efficiencies and production
  - Connectivity in rural areas to support market development and agritourism

#### **Agriculture Industry**

- Climate change adaptation/mitigation;
- Indigenous agriculture; and
- New entrants



#### **Agriculture Area Plan**

- Using the CCBAC report as a foundation in the development of an agriculture area plan will help to identify opportunities to:
  - ➤ Strengthen the industry
  - ➤ Contribute to its long-term sustainability
  - ➤ Increase food security in the region

#### **Agriculture Area Plan**

- Provide the North Star for the CRD and the ADAC to ensure it stays on the path, as leadership, membership, or funding changes
- Useful when submitting funding applications



#### **ADAC 2020 Activities - Advisory**

- Providing reports to the CRD Board of Directors on the:
  - ➤ Ministry of Agriculture Policy Intentions Paper: Residential Flexibility in the Agricultural Land Reserve
  - ➤ Ministry of Agriculture Intentions Paper: Rural Slaughter Modernization
  - ➤ Proposed Agricultural Land Reserve Exclusion Application Policy
- Presenting to the Central Cariboo Rural Caucus directors on the establishment of the Agricultural Development Advisory Committee.

#### **ADAC 2020 Activities - Administrative**


- ■ADAC membership review of member appointments;
- Requesting an increase to the number of potential ADAC members and their representation;
- ■ADAC information letter to North Cariboo First Nations; and
- Conducting an assessment of the ADAC.

#### **Future Direction**

- Suggestions from ADAC members during the assessment process can provide direction as to the actions the committee can target to:
  - ➤ Increase awareness of the agriculture industry;
  - Facilitate the industry planning process; and
  - Develop additional partnerships.

## **Agriculture Industry Awareness**

- Create
  "Producer/Processor
  Profiles"
- Include factual industrial data to support communications



#### **Agriculture Industry Awareness**

- Coordinate dissemination of economic & labour industry data
- Increase awareness of the functioning of the ADAC committee to the various agriculture sectors i.e. attend public events, fairs, etc. (post COVID)

- ADAC involvement in the Official Community Planning process
- Continue to build relationships with all the North Cariboo Rural Directors and all levels of government including First Nations



- Continue to provide a point of contact & communication dispersal within the industry;
- Develop a roster of other producers/processors to be invited to sub-committee or special topic meetings



Identify potential zones for industrial activities that support agriculture production; e.g.

- > further food processing
- >wool/fibre processing
- >animal feed processing



Explore the role of ADAC in supporting:

- Regional Immigration sponsorship and recruitment for the retention of skilled labour in meat slaughter/processing
- Partnerships with Small Scale Meat Processors/TRU/UNBC in establishing a Red Seal Trade Program for meat slaughter and processing training

#### **Partnerships**

- Partner with other organizations such as CNC to enlist local letters of support or advocate with local government
- Develop closer connections to the Chamber of Commerce
- Increase involvement of the committee in the CRD Economic Development Strategic Plan

#### **Strategic Planning Session**

- These and other suggestions will be targeted as the committee continues its work
- Organizing a strategic planning session in February
- Next phase of agriculture industry expansion
