### Memorandum:

Please find the attached proposed renewal agreements between the Central Cariboo Arts and Culture Society, the Cariboo Regional District and the City of Williams Lake.

The current five-year agreements with the Society expire at the end of December 2020. The arrangement includes two separate agreements that act together to enable the Society to deliver Central Cariboo Arts and Culture services on behalf of the Regional District as well as occupy and manage the Central Cariboo Arts Centre, which is owned by the City of Williams Lake.

The current agreement includes an annual payment from the Regional District to the Society of \$90,000 per year; the total of \$70,000 for service delivery and \$20,000 for management and operations of the arts centre.

The proposed renewal is for another five-year term at an increased amount as noted in Schedule B of the agreement, raising the total payment amount of \$102,000 in 2021 up to \$116,000 in 2025.

Key deliverables of the agreements include organization and delivery of the annual arts and culture project grants program, administration of the Fee for Service Agreements in the function as well as daily operation of the arts centre, including space rentals and working regularly with tenant groups.

## **Financial Implications:**

The agreements have an annual payment ranging from \$102,000 in 2021 to \$116,000 in 2025. This amount is allocated in the 2021-2025 Central Cariboo Arts and Culture function five-year financial plan as endorsed by the Joint Committee on October 28, 2020 and received by the Regional District Finance Committee at its meeting on October 22, 2020.

## **Policy Implications:**

The review and renewal of the agreements with the Society are a key goal of the 2020 Central Cariboo Arts and Culture function Business Plan.
