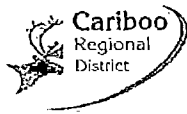

The Club bought scratchers for the groomer snowmobile which did not fit. Performance All-Terrain will provide new scratchers and install them.

The concrete footings by the club house main (member) entrance have been removed.

Rick called Bridge Lake Electric regarding a new septic field. Rick is pursuing a quote for the purpose of getting a grant. Rick wants to have a commercial grade septic system installed.

New Business

Steve Law motioned that the Club's 3 bank accounts be merged into one general account. Motion was seconded by Ian Henderson. All members were in favour.

The club house renters need a range hood in their kitchen, also the carpets need replacing. Rick motioned that we install a range hood as soon as possible. Rick will get a quote from Cariboo Bob to get the work done. Bruce seconded the motion. All members were in favour.

The Club has decided to put a float in the 100 Mile House Santa Claus Parade Friday Nov. 22. Rick proposed spending \$200 for Christmas lights for the float. Jim Kirby will supply a truck and trailer, 2 generators and 2 snowmobiles. The Club will include our new snowmobile and groomer. Bruce motioned to spend \$200 for lights. Ian seconded the motion.

Upgraded signage at the top of Ainsworth Rd is required to better point to the club house as the gate at the top of the road can be cause confusion. Also signage is required to identify the club house renter area as private.

The Club is going to make a trail ride itinerary for the upcoming sledding season. The ride proposals will be discussed next meeting and will be made available early January.

There is a work bee Sunday November 24. The purpose of the work bee is to make sure the trail to the GRST is open and if time permits, clear the trail known as the Circle Tour Route. The work group will leave the club house parking lot 9:30 am.

Gold Rush Snowmobile Trail (GRST) Update.

The GRST will be getting groomed again this year.

A new trail from the GRST to Mount Timothy has been established. The connection of the new trail to the GRST is at the intersection of Rail Lk Road and Bluff Road, where there is a parking lot.

There is also a parking lot at the intersection of the GRST and Stormy Rd, and a proposed lot off Wright Station Road on Buttler Road.
