Memorandum:

For the North Cariboo Joint Advisory Committee's consideration, please find the attached application to Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the Gold Rush Cycling Club. The request is for \$79,541 in grant funding under the Recreation Infrastructure Program to expand the Wonderland Trail Network.

The total project cost is \$113,630 with a complementary application for \$30,000 from the Province through Community Economic Recovery Infrastructure Program, and a \$7,000 contribution from the Gold Rush Cycling Club.

Prior to forwarding the proposal to NDIT for Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government with jurisdiction in the project.

Recent discussion at the Cariboo Regional District Board provided direction that NDIT applications for projects that fall under sub-regional recreation will be brought forward to the respective joint committee prior to going to the Regional District Board or City Council for ratification.
