- Offer direct financial assistance to individuals or families;
- Duplicate or replace services that fall within the mandate of senior levels of government or local service agency; or
- Support a Provincial or National fundraising campaign; or
- Be of a commercial nature

Grants for Assistance will be provided under the following categories:

1. **Capital Expenditure** – equipment purchase, construction, repair or upgrade of facilities
2. **Event/Special Project** – one-time special event, program or activity

We have planned our usual annual events such as dances, suppers, garage sales, stampede, hall rentals (for meetings, funerals, private events) however this is all subject to COVID restrictions. We have also planned raffles and auctions to fund the day to day maintenance of the hall for the next year due to restrictions currently in place. Stampede is always our biggest fundraiser.

1. Brief Description of Proposed Use of Grant Being Applied For:

We propose to use the grant to complete renovations that have been started, finishing the bathrooms and kitchens and to upgrade wiring in older portion of the hall. We also would like to use the grant to pay for some of the work (building the addition to lock up stage) that has already been done as we had limited fundraising opportunities this year. Our contractor has been very good about this and is completely understanding the situation and willing to help us as long as needed but we would prefer to pay him as soon as possible..

2. How do you know there is a need for this service/project in our community?

We know there is a need because while the Ulkatcho Band does have a hall, it is not generally considered available for the general public to utilize. We have the only other building that is large enough for any kind of event. However, until now there have been no washroom or kitchen facilities and with the recent pandemic this is not acceptable. We must be able to provide proper cleaning and sanitation. Being a remote community, having a place that we can provide some events over the course of the year, is very important to the mental wellbeing of our residents. Many of our residents are low income and so being able to provide subsidized events is also a big deal. By increasing the usability of the hall, we hope to generate more income in order that more free events can take place.

We have received a \$24,426 grant from Northern Development

4. Would you still be able to complete the project if you do not receive the other funds applied for?

We will complete the project but it will take a lot longer.

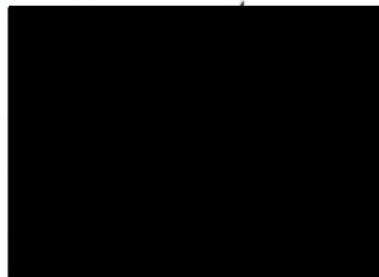

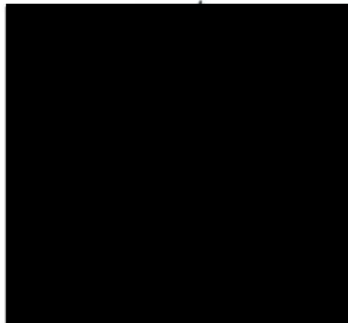

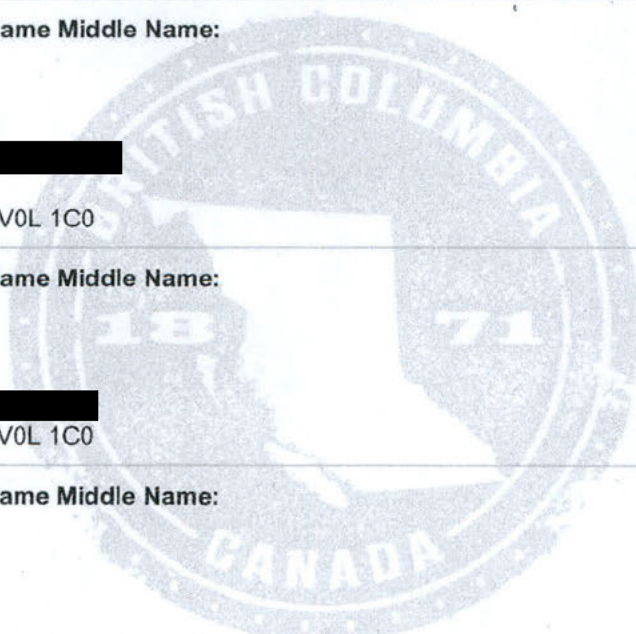
