Short Summary:

100 Mile Community Club Community Works Funding Project and Enabling Agreement

Memorandum:

Please find attached a financial request from the 100 Mile Community Club, to the Cariboo Regional District. The request is up to \$9,100 to perform a lighting upgrade at the 100 Mile Community Hall.

The lighting upgrade will involve replacing 142 fluorescent tubes T8-32 watts with four-foot LED lights at 14 watts, as well as removing all ballasts. The lighting upgrade is expected to result in savings of approximately 4,000 KWH/year, representing about 66% energy savings.

Because the community hall is not owned by the CRD, a contribution agreement between the Regional District and the 100 Mile Community Club is required for this project by UBCM under its Gas Tax Sharing Master Agreement with the federal government. Under the terms of the agreement, the community group is responsible for managing the project, maintaining financial records, reporting on measurable results and retaining ownership of the asset for a minimum of 10 years.

Financial Implications:

The proposal from the 100 Mile Community Club requests up to \$9,100 from the Community Hall Improvements envelope of the 2019 CWF program.

The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2019, including the Community Hall Improvements envelope which currently has a total of \$26,200 available. If this application from

the Williams Lake Curling Club is approved, \$9,100 will be committed, leaving a balance of \$17,100 available for community hall projects.

Policy Implications:

None. The Board approved the CWF funding schedule for 2019, including the Community Hall Improvements envelope. This project meets CWF criteria for the upgrade of lighting and heating for energy efficiency.
