Minutes of Meeting that took place at the LLH Cemetery On August 19, 2019

Volunteers in Attendance: Percy Ogden, Gale Ogden, Bryan Symmes, Terry Buckoll, Dot Buckoll, Dave Bailey, Penny Bailey, Paul Cowley, Mary Cowley, Brian Irvine, Ken Sanford, Mike Quinn

- 1) Discussed the break-in that occurred (guessing through the night of July 17, 2019)
  Reported to Police on July 18<sup>th</sup>. 2019 No suspects. Items taken from the shed were:
  Craftsman Ride on Mower, 3 Stihl trimmers, 1
  Honda leaf blower, 3 gas cans. The 3 gas push mowers were not taken. Estimating the current value of those items as \$ 3,680.00
- 2) Discussion re: the ways and means of replacing the stolen items as they are necessary in the maintenance of the Cemetery. We agree that there needs to be a secure way of storing any future maintenance equipment bought. It was suggested that a Steel Container would be a good thing to have. We will contact the Big Steel Box Company for pricing on used or new containers. As well we agree that there needs to be a security camera set

up. Once we have those in place we can check into getting insurance.

- 3) Gale will check with the CRD for a possible grant. As well; we can submit letters to request any donations from groups i.e. the Lac La Hache Community Club; and the 108 Lions Club.
- 4) Discussed current pricing of the cost of Burial plots and Cremation sites (opening and closing). We have researched the charges from similar small Cemeteries (Roe Lake and Forest Grove). We will increase our prices to line up more with current prices. We are a not for profit organization but we want to be able to cover costs of such things as maintenance costs, back hoe charges etc.

As well; we will have allowance to be flexible for pricing for special circumstances.

- 5) We want to update the volunteer list. Bob
  Buckland was president for many years but has
  moved. Percy Ogden is now president of the
  Cemetery. This list will be forwarded to the BPCPA
  (Business Practices& Consumer Protection
  Authority). The Lac La Hache Cemetery has a
  current license # 15368 which is necessary to
  operate a place of Internment.
- 6) Percy Ogden thanked everyone for their verbal input and the meeting was closed. The volunteers then proceeded to tidy up the Cemetery.
