Memorandum:

The Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy has provided Regional Districts with a guidance document for Solid Waste Management Plan updates. This document was not available during the last Solid Waste Management Planning process.

The guidance document provided the template for the attached Terms of Reference (TOR) for the Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC).

The TOR are clear that the SWAC may consist of both Public (PAC) and Technical (TAC) Advisory members, but only one member (the Chair) of the Board Solid Waste Management Committee (BSWMC) will be a member of the SWAC.

The SWAC will report to the BSWMC and the BSWMC in turn will make recommendations to the CRD Board. Director Richmond, as a member of both the SWAC and the BSWMC, will be the liaison between the two committees and, with support of staff, will provide regular updates to the BSWMC.
