After the CAO Evaluation process that occurred in 2020, the CRD Board Chair requested that the CAO Evaluation and Compensation Policy be amended to include a performance incentive between the existing \$1,000 and \$2,500 incentives. The attached policy offers a new incentive between the two current amounts and provides clarity for average ratings that inevitably include decimals (e.g. averaging 16 numerical ratings almost always results in a fractional final number).
