Northern Health Funding Request – Quesnel Long-Term Care Business Plan

## Memorandum:

Northern Health has made a formal request of the Cariboo Chilcotin Regional Hospital District to fund the Quesnel Long-Term Care Business Plan. Total cost is \$900,000 of which the CCRHD is responsible for 100% of the cost. Should the project get formal approval from the Ministry of Health the \$900,000 will be applied to the CCRHD's 40% share of the costs.
